Hemlock Woolly Adelgid (HWA)

DustyBlues has, in recent months, volunteered to hike several locations in the Hocking Hills to search for signs of a more recent infestation that has the potential to eradicate all of our amazing hemlock forests.

The infestation is by a non-native invasive insect, the hemlock woolly adelgid (HWA), that was accidentally introduced in Virginia in the 1950's. This same species has caused widespread devastation, especially in the Smoky Mountains, has the potential to eliminate our hemlock forests here in the Hocking Hills region and beyond.

There have been multiple findings of HMA in areas of Southern Ohio including

several here in the Hocking Hills. DustyBlues has been doing our small part with various Divisions of the ODNR as well as private groups and academic institutions. These various groups have management plans in place for identifying, establishing protocols, and treatments to minimize the impact of HWA.

In our past the Chestnut, Ash and Elm trees have been affected by their own blights and to a large extent eradicated from our region and beyond.

Can you imagine the Hocking Hills without these beautiful forests!!

Stay tuned and we will try to keep you updated as to the progress of so many considerable folks and their efforts.
